Route 4 La Sopa- Espai Autogestionat i Centre Cívic del Barri Vell

La Sopa is a social and welfare organization to help and give support to homeless people or in a situation of severe poverty and exclusion. The objectives and functions of the reception centre are 1) To provide a welcome service to people in a situation of need or with special difficulties for their economic and social autonomy; 2) To carry out an intervention that combines assistance with reintegration and the promotion of personal autonomy; 3) To establish effective cooperation with other services and resources in the area to deal with the multidimensionality of the situations attended to, in social, health, labour, legal and housing aspects.

El Centre Cívic del Barri Vell is open to anyone who wants to join in to share proposals, ideas and concerns. A local facility with a high degree of versatility that offers educational, cultural and social services for the whole of the city. It welcomes all those associations and organisations with community and neighbourhood initiatives. An innovative approach, which includes citizen participation in all its projects. A civic centre that aims to encourage creativity in the framework of social participation by welcoming and promoting new social initiatives.

Route 1 & 2 Ludoteca and Ateneu Popular, Salt

Ludoteca de Salt is a public service characterised by educational intervention in diversity. They also collaborate in specific projects in the community environment, in collaboration with other services, entities (social, cultural, leisure), groups (young people, older people, people from different backgrounds).

The Ateneu Popular Coma Cros is one of the first community management projects in the counties of Girona, to put into practice the idea that the citizens themselves are the ones who govern a public facility. The aim of the Ateneu is to be a tool and an asset for Salt, a space open to initiatives and projects that emerge from the residents. These projects are autonomous spaces where the aim is for them to grow from the participation and empowerment of the participants, as dynamic and diverse spaces in all aspects, which raise awareness and improve our environment, with values such as sustainability, social cohesion, feminism and diversity.

They are divided into four areas: the socio-labour area, which includes business activities and job placement services; the area of services to people, which accompanies them beyond the workplace; the area of specialised care; and the training area.
